The author has published a number of papers and memoirs on this subject during the last forty years, terminating with a summary of the case, which appeared in the Monthly Notices of the Royal Astronomical Society for March, 1904. The deviations in question offer the greatest enigma yet encountered in explaining the motions of the heavenly bodies, and the present paper may be regarded as a contribution to the study of the problem thus offered. While the work was in progress the completing chapter of Professor Brown's Theory of the Moon's Motion appeared. The actual work being based on Delaunay's theory, it seemed to be desirable to revise and correct it by Brown's results....
