Fortunately the deceased left interesting memoranda of the history of his family and of his own life. It could be wished that more of these veteran pioneers had done the same, and placed them in the hands of those who might make use of them. From Mr. Willson's memoranda we gather that his family was of Norman descent, having (as he learned from the family tradition) come to England with William the Conqueror, and settled in Northumberland. In William III's time, a branch from which his family descended accompanied that Monarch to Ireland, where, like many of his companions in arms, he settled in the North.
